

The Rebele Journalism Internship Program

Stanford University students have a unique opportunity to receive stipends of up to \$5,000 for internships at qualifying news organizations in the United States through the generosity of a Stanford alumnus, Rowland Rebele, and his wife, Pat Rebele.

In addition, the Rebele program funds the Rebele First Amendment Internship in conjunction with the California First Amendment Coalition, Rebele PhD Fellows, and occasionally special projects, especially those involving First Amendment issues.

Eligibility and Application

To be eligible for funding through the Rebele Internship funding, applicants have to be active students at Stanford University during the current or previous quarter and pursue an internship of sufficient length - paid or unpaid - with a qualifying U.S. news organization. Please contact the [Rebele Internship Program Director](#) to inquire about the eligibility of any U.S. news organization not presently listed. Magazine and broadcasting internships cannot be funded through the Rebele Internship Program.

Funds are limited and funding is awarded to eligible students on a first come first served basis. If an internship is already funded by another resource at Stanford, the Rebele Internship Program will not provide additional support.

To inquire about internship opportunities, students should contact the editor or the person in charge of the paper's internship program and provide the required application materials if applicable. Once the internship is secured and the terms are set, prospective interns apply for Rebele funding by submitting the completed Rebele Internship Application form to the [Rebele Internship Program Director](#). A contract email will be dispatched to the applicant and the internship supervisor listing the terms of the Rebele internship asking for email approval from both parties.

It is the student's responsibility to complete the application process for Rebele funding before starting the internship as it will not be granted retroactively.

For internships spanning beyond one quarter, student have to apply for a Rebele stipend for each individual quarter.

Rebele Interns cannot receive academic credit for a Rebele internship.

Deliverables

Stipends at Stanford University are issued as a means of support to defray expenses while students pursue extracurricular activities to enhance their education. Stipends are not given as payment in return for hours worked. Towards the end of the internship, students are asked to send in 3-5 work samples along with a letter to Mr. and Mrs. Rebele thanking them and describing their internship experience. Stipends are processed upon receipt of these materials. All letters and samples are collated in a binder and forwarded to Mr. and Mrs. Rebele. To ensure it is recommended that students set up direct deposit through Axess.
