Who we are:

Mission Local is a hyperlocal news site based in the culturally vibrant, always-happening Mission District of San Francisco. We're an award-winning publication that reaches about 100,000 unique web visitors a month. We're also syndicated on SFGate.com.

As a historic hotbed of artistic movements, Latino culture, radical activism, foodies, and, most recently, a new wave of tech companies and workers, the Mission is a constantly fascinating and rewarding place to report on. We have been a key player in documenting this special part of the city, breaking and leading the coverage of many citywide and national stories.

In addition to print stories, we also produce short videos, photo essays, and a biweekly podcast. At present, we have two full-time reporters, an editor and a weekly columnist on staff.

What you'll do:

Reporting interns – Mission Local is an especially great place for new journalists given its focus on mentorship and on-the-ground training. Interns get a lot of assignments and a lot of editing. You also join a strong alumni group. Former Mission Local contributors have landed jobs at pretty much every major news outlet in America—the Washington Post, the NY Times, NPR and the LA Times.
