JOB DESCRIPTION

Reveal is looking for summer interns to work as research assistants on a variety of investigative projects. Interns will work 8-12 weeks between June 1 and August 13. These dates may be flexible depending on the schedule of the candidate.

The research assistant will work directly with Reveal reporters and producers to assist with a wide range of reporting tasks, depending on the needs of the organization. Jobs might include research and reporting, fact checking, going through public records, data journalism, locating archival footage and tape as well as logging and transcribing, among others.

QUALIFICATIONS / EXPERIENCE

Requirements:

1. Able to independently handle reporting tasks, in-depth research, basic Excel work
2. Familiarity with spreadsheets and basic formulas to organize data (sorting and filtering for instance).
3. Comfort with writing detailed memos about the research process.
4. Collaborate and communicate across teams
5. Display high cultural competency and contribute to an inclusive environment
6. Familiarity with investigative reporting a plus
7. Familiarity with audio or video production a plus
8. Familiarity with data work a plus

This does not describe everything we are looking for. Our newsroom is successful because of the sum of its parts – we recognize that no one person will be equally strong in every area and that some candidates will bring other strengths or experiences that we haven't described here. If you are passionate about our work and have a vision to share with us, please apply. We will carefully consider every serious applicant.
